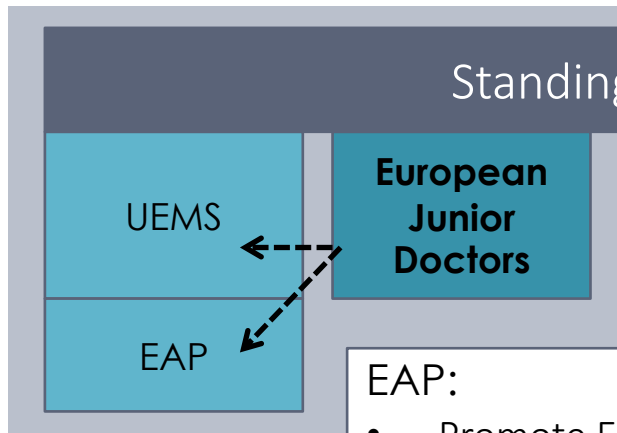

## EAP is the UEMS Section and Board of Paediatrics in charge of education

EBP and permanent councils work on

- Up-to-date European Core Curriculum  
*including goals, competencies & skills, and assessments*
- Up-to-date training requirements  
*including those for trainees, trainers and training institutions*
- Up-to-date subspecialty syllabi
- European textbooks and e-learning
- European Board Exam
- Electronic unified Logbooks
- Appraisal of specialised paediatric examinations
- Accreditation of training centres

**EAP** is also in charge of advocacy
